

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

IN THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS, A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE INCLUDES ANY SHOW AWARD THAT COUNTS TOWARDS THE TITLE OF CHAMPION UNDER THE RULES OF ANY GOVERNING BODY RECOGNISED BY THE KENNEL CLUB. SHOW AWARDS ISSUED BY THE IRISH KENNEL CLUB WHICH COUNT TOWARDS THE TITLE OF CHAMPION, SHALL BE FIVE POINT GREEN STARS OR MORE WINS AT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW IN BREED CLASSES WHERE CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES ARE NOT ON OFFER SHALL BE COUNTED AS WINS AT OPEN SHOWS.

IN ESTIMATING THE NUMBER OF AWARDS WON, ALL WINS UP TO AND INCLUDING THE 7th DAY BEFORE THE DATE OF CLOSING (i.e. 23rd June 2007) OF ENTRIES SHALL BE COUNTED WHEN ENTERING FOR ANY CLASS.

WINS IN VARIETY CLASSES DO NOT COUNT FOR ENTRY IN BREED CLASSES, BUT WHEN ENTERING FOR VARIETY CLASSES, WINS IN BOTH BREED AND VARIETY CLASSES MUST BE COUNTED. A FIRST PRIZE DOES NOT INCLUDE A SPECIAL PRIZE OF WHATEVER VALUE.

A DOG IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY IN VARIETY CLASSES UNLESS ALSO ENTERED & SUBSEQUENTLY EXHIBITED IN A BREED CLASS WHERE SUCH A CLASS IS PROVIDED FOR WHICH IT IS ELIGIBLE. EXEMPTIONS FROM THIS REGULATION ARE:-

- (1) A PUPPY, UNLESS A CLASS FOR DOGS UNDER 12 MONTHS OF AGE FOR WHICH IT IS ELIGIBLE IS PROVIDED FOR THE BREED.
- (2) A DOG IN ANY VARIETY VETERAN CLASS
- (3) AS PROVIDED IN KENNEL CLUB DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES.

IF AN EXHIBITOR REPORTS BEFORE THE JUDGING OF A CLASS OR CLASSES THAT A DOG HAS BEEN ENTERED WHICH IS INELIGIBLE, THE EXHIBITOR MAY CHOOSE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:-

- (1) WITHDRAWAL - THE DOG MAY BE WITHDRAWN FROM COMPETITION SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS OF REGULATIONS 9(i) AND 20.
- (2) TRANSFER -
(A) IF A DOG IS INELIGIBLE FOR A CLASS OR CLASSES AS REGARDS ITS BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER IT TO THE EQUIVALENT CLASS OR CLASSES FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT AND, IN THE EVENT OF THERE BEING NO EQUIVALENT CLASS, MINOR PUPPY & PUPPY EXCEPTED, TO THE OPEN CLASS FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.
(B) FOR AN EXHIBIT ENTERED INCORRECTLY IN A MINOR PUPPY CLASS OR PUPPY CLASS, WHICH IS OVER AGE BUT UNDER 12 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE OR 18 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE RESPECTIVELY, THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER THE EXHIBIT TO THE PUPPY CLASS OR THE JUNIOR CLASS RESPECTIVELY FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT AND IN THE EVENT OF THERE BEING NO PUPPY OR JUNIOR CLASS RESPECTIVELY TO THE OPEN CLASS FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.
(C) FOR ANY REASON OTHER THAN THE ABOVE, THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER IT TO THE OPEN CLASS FOR THE CORRECT BREED, COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.
IF AN EXHIBIT ARRIVES LATE AND MISSES A CLASS, EVEN IF IT IS THE ONLY CLASS IN WHICH IT IS ENTERED, THE DOG MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANY OTHER CLASS.

PUPPY	FOR DOGS OF 6 & NOT EXCEEDING 12 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1st DAY OF THE SHOW
JUNIOR	FOR DOGS OF 6 & NOT EXCEEDING 18 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1st DAY OF THE SHOW
MAIDEN	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE OR A FIRST PRIZE AT AN OPEN OR CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW (MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY, & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT.)
NOVICE	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE OR THREE OR MORE FIRST PRIZES AT OPEN OR CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS (MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY, & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT.)
SPECIAL YEARLING	FOR DOGS OF 6 & NOT EXCEEDING 24 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1st DAY OF THE SHOW.
GRADUATE	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE OR FOUR OR MORE FIRST PRIZES AT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS (MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY, & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT.)
POST GRADUATE	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON A CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE OR FIVE OR MORE FIRST PRIZES AT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS (MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY, & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT.)
LIMIT	FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT BECOME SHOW CHAMPIONS UNDER KENNEL CLUB REGULATIONS OR UNDER THE RULES OF ANY GOVERNING BODY RECOGNISED BY THE KENNEL CLUB OR WON 7 OR MORE FIRST PRIZES IN ALL AT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS IN LIMIT AND OPEN CLASSES CONFINED TO THE BREED, WHETHER RESTRICTED OR NOT AT SHOWS WHERE CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES WERE OFFERED FOR THE BREED.
OPEN	FOR ALL DOGS OF ALL BREEDS FOR WHICH THE CLASS IS PROVIDED AND ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THE SHOW.
VETERAN	FOR DOGS OF SEVEN YEARS OF AGE AND OVER ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW.
NON-SPORTING	CONFINED TO THE EXHIBITION OF BREEDS OF DOGS WITHIN THE TOY, WORKING, PASTORAL AND UTILITY GROUPS ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THE SHOW
SPORTING	CONFINED TO THE EXHIBITION OF BREEDS OF DOGS WITHIN THE GUNDOG, HOUND, AND TERRIER GROUPS ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THE SHOW.
SCOTTISH NATIVE BREEDS	CAIRN, DANDIE DINMONT, SCOTTISH, SKYE, WEST HIGHLAND

- EXHIBITS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED TO BEST IN SHOW COMPETITION AFTER A PERIOD OF 10 MINUTES HAS ELAPSED SINCE THE ANNOUNCEMENT THAT EXHIBITS ARE REQUIRED FOR JUDGING, UNLESS THEY HAVE BEEN UNAVOIDABLY DELAYED BY PREVIOUS JUDGING NOT BEING COMPLETED ON TIME, & THEN ONLY WITH THE SPECIAL PERMISSION OF THE SHOW MANAGEMENT.
- NO MODIFICATIONS WILL BE MADE TO THIS SCHEDULE EXCEPT BY PERMISSION OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE OF THE KENNEL CLUB, WHICH WILL BE FOLLOWED BY ADVERTISEMENT IN THE CANINE PRESS WHEREVER POSSIBLE.
- ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE FAMILIAR WITH KENNEL CLUB REGULATION F (ANNEX B) REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION.
- ALL DOGS RESIDENT OUTSIDE THE UK MUST BE ISSUED WITH A KENNEL CLUB AUTHORITY TO COMPETE NUMBER BEFORE ENTRY TO THE SHOW/EVENT CAN BE MADE. ALL OVERSEAS ENTRIES WITHOUT AN AUTHORITY TO COMPETE NUMBER WILL BE RETURNED TO THE EXHIBITOR/COMPETITOR
- YOUR DOG IS VULNERABLE AND AT RISK DURING HOT WEATHER AND THE KENNEL CLUB OFFERS THE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE TO HELP GUIDE YOU THROUGH THE DO'S AND DON'TS TRAVELLING TO AND WHILST AT KC LICENSED EVENTS.
WHEN TRAVELLING TO A SHOW PLEASE TAKE A MOMENT TO CONSIDER WHETHER THE ROUTE TO THE SHOW IS ON A BUSY HOLIDAY ROUTE, AND LEAVE EARLIER TO AVOID INCREASED TIME IN TRAFFIC JAMS.
IF YOUR VEHICLE IS NOT AIR-CONDITIONED SERIOUSLY CONSIDER WHETHER TRAVELLING TO THE SHOW IS A GOOD IDEA AT ALL.
THE VEHICLE SHOULD BE AS FULLY VENTILATED AS POSSIBLE, AND PLENTY OF STOPS SHOULD BE TAKEN, WITH LOTS OF WATER AVAILABLE TO DRINK.
ENSURE YOUR DOG IS NOT SITTING IN FULL SUNLIGHT. THERE SHOULD BE PLENTY OF FREE FLOWING AIR AROUND THE DOG.
WHEN AT THE SHOW, NEVER LEAVE YOUR DOG IN THE VEHICLE.
KEEP THE DOG IN THE SHADE – TAKE YOUR OWN SHADE FOR EXAMPLE A LARGE UMBRELLA AND ALWAYS HAVE PLENTY OF WATER AVAILABLE TO DRINK SO YOUR DOG STAYS WELL HYDRATED.
AVOID YOUR DOG TAKING PART IN UNNECESSARY EXERTION, OR FROM STANDING IN EXPOSED SUNLIGHT FOR EXTENDED LENGTHS OF TIME.
REMEMBER, IF YOU FEEL HOT YOUR DOG IS VERY LIKELY TO FEEL MUCH HOTTER AND DEHYDRATED, AND THIS COULD LEAD TO DIRE RESULTS. PLEASE LOOK AFTER YOUR DOG'S WELFARE.

2. DOGS WILL BE RECEIVED AT ANY TIME BUT IT IS THE EXHIBITORS RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT EXHIBITS ARE AVAILABLE FOR JUDGING WHEN REQUIRED.
3. JUDGING WILL COMMENCE AT 10.00am PROMPT IN SCHEDULE ORDER
4. EXHIBITS MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOW AFTER THEIR JUDGING HAS BEEN COMPLETED. THE SHOW WILL CLOSE HALF AN HOUR AFTER ALL JUDGING HAS BEEN COMPLETED.
5. THE USE OF COOKING STOVES IN THE PROXIMITY OF TENTING AND BENCHING AREAS IS FORBIDDEN EXCEPT AS AUTHORISED BY THE SHOW MANAGEMENT.

10. THE MATING OF BITCHES WITHIN THE PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW IS FORBIDDEN.
11. BEST PUPPY IN SHOW.
 WHERE A BEST PUPPY IN SHOW COMPETITION IS SCHEDULED THE BEST PUPPY IN SHOW IS A PUPPY WHICH HAS COMPETED & IS UNBEATEN BY ANY OTHER PUPPY EXHIBITED AT THE SAME SHOW. A PUPPY IS A DOG OF SIX AND NOT EXCEEDING TWELVE CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE SHOW. WHERE THE BEST OF BREED, OR BEST IN SHOW IS A PUPPY IT WILL ALSO AUTOMATICALLY BE BEST PUPPY IN BREED, & BEST PUPPY IN SHOW RESPECTIVELY. SIMILARLY IF THE RESERVE BEST OF BREED OR RESERVE BEST IN SHOW IS A PUPPY WHICH HAS ONLY BEEN BEATEN BY AN ADULT DOG IT WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE BEST PUPPY IN BREED OR BEST PUPPY IN SHOW RESPECTIVELY. CONSEQUENTLY SELECTION OF BEST PUPPY IN BREED, & BEST PUPPY IN SHOW MUST FOLLOW SELECTION OF BEST OF BREED, & BEST IN SHOW RESPECTIVELY.
 PROVISIO.
 FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS REGULATION, DOGS BEATEN IN COMPETITION FOR STUD DOG, BROOD BITCH, PROGENY, BRACE AND TEAM OR A SPECIAL AWARD CONFINED TO ONE BREED WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED TO BE A BEATEN DOG..
12. BEST IN SHOW
 THE DOG DECLARED BEST IN SHOW IS A DOG WHICH HAS COMPETED AND IS UNBEATEN BY ANY OTHER DOG EXHIBITED AT THE SAME SHOW.
 BEST IN SHOW MUST BE SELECTED FROM ALL UNBEATEN WINNING DOGS. RESERVE BEST IN SHOW MUST BE SELECTED FROM THE REMAINING UNBEATEN WINNING DOGS FOLLOWING SELECTION OF BEST IN SHOW.
 PROVISIO
 FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS REGULATION, DOGS BEATEN IN COMPETITION FOR STUD DOG, BROOD BITCH, PROGENY, BRACE AND TEAM OR A SPECIAL AWARD CONFINED TO ONE BREED WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED TO BE A BEATEN DOG.
WITHDRAWAL FROM OTHER COMPETITION.
 DOGS WHICH BECOME ELIGIBLE FOR BEST IN SHOW OR BEST PUPPY IN SHOW MAY BE WITHDRAWN FROM ALL OTHER COMPETITION PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION FOR BEST IN SHOW OR BEST PUPPY IN SHOW IN ORDER TO REMAIN UNBEATEN. A DOG BEATEN IN COMPETITION FOR BEST IN SHOW MAY SUBSEQUENTLY BE EXHIBITED IN ALL COMPETITION FOR WHICH IT WAS PREVIOUSLY ELIGIBLE. THE DOGS DECLARED BEST IN SHOW & RESERVE BEST IN SHOW HOWEVER, MUST NOT COMPETE IN ANY SUBSEQUENT COMPETITION.

KENNEL CLUB SHOW REGULATION - F
REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

- 1) These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule 42.
 - a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there at.
 - b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
- 2) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition either before or at the show.
Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat of a dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3) No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed and nothing may be done, calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive, except:-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee
 - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any kind.
 - (c) The shortening of tails of customary docked breeds.
 - (d) Operations to prevent breeding where the animal has progeny registered at the Kennel Club.
- 4) The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5) Any individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6) Any objection by an individual related to a infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

NOTE

The Officers and Committee reserve the right to alter the judging order if deemed necessary.

KENNEL CLUB RULE F(1), 17f

The attraction of attention of exhibits by any method from outside the ring is prohibited, it is the duty of the Judge, Steward or Show Management noticing such attraction to ask that it cease.
