**ALL horses in attendance will need to provide the following**

A) Compliant EI vaccines within SIX calendar months of the show date, recorded in the horse's passport, as required by the Rules and signed by a veterinary surgeon.

B) Equine Influenza Declaration Form (EIDF), which details the horse's temperature on the morning of arrival to the racecourse/showfield.

These details will be checked on arrival, either by the racecourse vet or a representative veterinary from the show.

**DO NOT UNLOAD YOUR HORSE UNTIL THE EIDF FORMS HAVE BEEN COLLECTED AND CHECKED. VETS WILL BE DOING RANDOM TEMPERATURE CHECKS THROUGHOUT THE DAY.**

**A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR HORSES PASSPORT TO INCLUDE IDENTITY PAGES AND VACCINE PAGES TO BE SENT WITH ENTRIES. IF PASSPORTS ARE NOT PRESENTED OR DO NOT COMPLY WE CANNOT ACCEPT YOUR ENTRIES. THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY AND WELLBEING OF ALL OTHER HORSES COMPETING.**

THERE WILL BE RANDOM PASSPORT AND EIDF CHECKS DURING THE SHOW DAY.

PLEASE DO NOT SET OFF ON THE MORNING OF THE SHOW IF YOU THINK YOUR HORSE/PONY IS UNWELL.
